The state of the art Tatuus chassis was mated to a 190bhp normally aspirated VW 2.0L German F3 specification power unit. The series is the only credible junior Formula career step in the Asian region and has grown in strength during 2013. The 2014 season promises even larger grid sizes with tough and exciting competition.

Formula Masters Schedule

- International Series open to drivers of 15 years of age (by January 1st 2014) and over holding an International D or C licence
- Six events, 18 races
- 3 day events plus official test day
- Up to 120 minutes track time on official test day at each event
- 1 x 30 minute free practice, 1 x 30 minute QTT (15 minute Q1, 5 minute break followed by 15 minute Q2) and 2 x 25 minute and 1 x 15 minute race at each event

2014 Race Package

- Lease of 2014 Specification Formula Masters car
- Payment of all management and administration costs
- Payment of all sea freight and transportation costs
- •Team Management
- Mechanical service
- Event registration fees
- Race engineer, driver coaching and in-depth data analysis
- New dry race tyres supplied as per regulations (3 sets drys)
- One set of wet weather tyres supplied at 1st race
- •All consumables and equipment to run a car
- Official Test fee (at events) for the team to run the car
- Large branding space on car allocated to Driver
- Race car finished in Eurasia livery
- Hospitality passes proved to the driver



Extra Costs

What is not included in the race fee:

- •Engine changes due to driver error (overrevs, ignoring alarms etc.)
- Additional wet weather tyres (we provide one new set at the first event)
- •Additional dry official test tyres at the first pre-event official test of the season it is optional for the driver to use up to three additional new sets of dry tyres. At subsequent events one additional dry new set is allowed for the official test. Cost is Euro 730 per set.
- •Insurance Premium and Excess The driver is responsible for the insurance premium (six event premium Euro 6000 in 2013, 2014 to be announced) and excess payment of Euro 3500 (2013 level, 2014 to be announced) for the first claim rising to Euro 5000 for subsequent claims. Maximum payout is Euro15,000. Any damage beyond this amount is for the driver's account. All accident damage under Euro3500 per accident, or Euro 5000 after one insurance claim, is for the driver's account.
- •Drivers own flight, accommodation and transport costs.



Test Venues

TEST VENUES

Sepang F1 Circuit – Limited number of days are available at this challenging Malaysian Formula One track.

Clark International Circuit – The FIA sanctioned 4.km circuit is based in the Clark Special Economic Zone in the Philippines. The challenging circuit features two long straights and 18 turns. Five star hotels and an International Airport make this an ideal testing venue which has plenty of test days available.







Training for novices

We recommend that drivers who have not previously tested in a Formula Car undertake a minimum of two days training in our Formula BMW car.

This allows the driver to learn how to brake, change gear and control the clutch in a less powerful car. It is particularly recommended for karting graduates.





Test Dates and Costs - Sepang

Pre-season testing at the Sepang F1 Circuit in Malaysia will take place on the following dates:

December: 16-18

January: 6-8, 28-30

February: 7-9

April: To be announced

New tyres (minimum one set, two sets recommended per day) cost Eur 730 per set.

Test fee: Euro 2500 per day plus new tyres and accidental damage.

The cars must be insured, premium is Euro 300 per day for Euro 15,000 coverage with Euro 3500 excess

Eurasia can also offer training in our Formula BMW cars. Cost is Euro 2000 per day plus new tyres and accidental damage.



Test Dates and Costs - Clark

Clark International Circuit is open for testing most days of the week. We have two Formula BMW and one Formula Pilota car available. The latter is identical to a Formula Masters car with the exception of the engine which is a turbo FIAT power unit as raced in 2011-2012.

Cost per day is Euro 1800 for the F.BMW and Euro 2300 for the F.Pilota car.

New tyres, accidental damage and insurance premiums are extra.
