LMP Ladder to the Top

The Asian Le Mans Sprint Cup is the foundation of the ACO (organizer of the Le Mans 24 Hours, World Endurance Championship and European and Asian Le Mans) pyramid to the top in Le Mans Prototype (LMP) racing.

Eurasia Motorsport allows drivers to develop and progress within the same organization making each upward step easier. Drivers can progress from Formula Masters to Asian Le Mans Sprint Cup and then to Asian LMS P3 before graduating to LMP2 in Asia, Europe and eventually the Le Mans 24H, a part of the World Endurance Championship. Eurasia is the only LMP team globally with this ladder already in place.

2017 Asian Le Mans Sprint Cup

- Three events all at the Sepang F1 Circuit in Malaysia, May 5-7, July 21-23 and August 18-20
- Three classes, LMP3, CN and GT
- Drivers must hold a minimum International C licence and be 16 years old or above
- One or two drivers may share the car. Silver or bronze drivers only. If two silvers share extra time is added to the compulsory pit stop minimum time
- Thursday – Administrative checks and unofficial testing (tbc)
- Friday – 2 X 45 minute Official Practice sessions
- Saturday – 2 x 15 minute qualifying sessions, race one (one hour)
- Sunday – Race two (one hour)
- Compulsory timed pit stop between 25 and 35 minutes into the race

- Nissan VK50 V8 5 Litre 420 hp engine
- Marelli engine management, Cosworth steering wheel and data logging
- Xtrac 6 speed semi automatic paddle shift gearbox
- Brembo brake system, 6 pot calipers with steel discs
- Double wishbone puhrod system
- Three-way dampers with third element front and rear
- Aerodynamics developed with CFD
