## **FRD LMP3 Championship**



Launched in 2017 the FRD LMP3 Championship was a new concept organized by experienced Chinese promotor, FRD, and approved by the ACO, the organizer of the Le Mans 24 Hours and the World Endurance Championship. It proved to be a tremendous success with well supported events, great media coverage, competitive racing and large crowds.

- The 2018 Series will expand to 5 events, all in China
- 16 car grids for 2018.

#### Each event consist of:

- 2 x one hour free practice sessions
- 2 x 10 minute qualifying sessions
- 50 Minute Race One with compulsory timed pit stop
- One hour Race Two with compulsory timed pit stop
- ACO scrutineer
- Controlled tyres and fuel

#### **Race Dates**



The season starts on April 27-29 at Shanghai International Circuit, running on the full Grand Prix configuration. Following that a two-event swing that demonstrates the fast growth of motorsport in China, a trip to newly opened Ningbo International Speedpark, which hosted a round of the FIA WTCC in October 2017, on the last weekend in May, followed by a visit to the new FIA Grade 2 track, Zhengzhou International Circuit.

The series will then visit Zhuhai for the Autumn edition of the Pan Delta Super Racing Festival in September, followed by a return to Shanghai on October 12-14.
