

**2019 CHINA ENDURANCE SERIES LMP3 GUIDE** 

Launched in 2017 the FRD LMP3 Championship was a new concept organized by experienced Chinese promotor, FRD. It proved to be a tremendous success with well supported events, great media coverage, competitive racing and large crowds. In 2018 the Series was renamed the China Endurance Series.

• The 2019 Series will consist of four events, three in China with the final event in Korea.

#### Each event consists of:

- 2 x one hour free practice sessions
- 2 x 10 minute qualifying sessions
- 50 Minute Race One with compulsory timed pit stop
- One hour Race Two with compulsory timed pit stop
- Controlled tyres and fuel

The season starts on May 24-25 at Ningbo International Circuit, the newly opened circuit already a driver favourite. Following that the series goes to the Tianjin V1 Circuit designed by Helmet Tilke and featuring a street circuit section. Our drivers last year thought it was one the most challenging tracks on which they had competed.

The series will then visit Zhuhai for the Autumn edition of the Pan Delta Super Racing Festival in September, followed by a final race at the ex Formula One circuit in Korea.
