#### **2016** Race Package

Our fee for the 2016 Asian Le Mans Series is Euro 30,000 per driver per event.

What is not included in the race fee:

- Engine and gearbox damage due to driver error (over-revs, ignoring alarms etc.)
- •Insurance Excess In the event of an accident the driver is responsible for the insurance excess payment of Euro 25,000. Maximum pay out is Euro125,000. Any damage beyond this amount is for the driver's account. All accident damage under Euro 25,000 per accident is for the driver's account.
- •The driver is only responsible for damage caused when he is in control of the car, he is not responsible for damage costs caused by the other drivers sharing the car
- •Unofficial test fees some events may have paid practice on Thursday of race week. Fee is Euro 5000 per driver.
- •Drivers own flight, accommodation and transport costs. We can arrange accommodation and rental cars for you
